5705 Undergraduates

Error: **±0.08**

$$sample = \frac{Z^2p(1-p)}{error^2} = \frac{1.96^2(0.5)(1-0.5)}{0.08^2} = 150$$

Responses: 36 (24%)

Phase II

We require 114 (150-36) more responses

We require at least 463 more emails


We sent out 579 emails







Greek Affiliation





To summarize demographics...


123/138 Responses

Too many Sophomores. Too Few Seniors. Unrepresentative.


Male: Female ratio = 39:61 Reversed Ratio in reality

So what do students believe?

Greek organizations have old archives - 75%

Using archives isn't cheating, and old exams are ethical - 60%

Archives give students an advantage - 90%

Access to Archives is fair - 62%

To conclude what we have so far...

Students do not know how CMU defines cheating - 71% incorrect

75% of Students would appreciate and use an official campus-wide archive
